Cellular Phones and Portable Electronic Devices

Cellular phones or other electronic devices may be used only in the parking lot for conversations. Cellular phones (on silent) may be used only in search or text mode in the clubhouse area. Members and guests can carry their phones on the course in silent mode and should be used only in the event of an emergency.

Dress Code

Clubhouse

It is prohibited for all members and their guests to wear the following:

- ✓ Any denim clothing
- ✓ Yoga pants (permitted during yoga sessions only), jogging pants, leggings and spandex
- ✓ Sweat suits, biker shorts and short shorts
- ✓ Cargo pants and cargo shorts
- ✓ Overalls
- ✓ Golf caps and/or hats (men)
- ✓ T-shirts, tank tops, halter tops and crop tops
- ✓ Flip flop type sandals
- ✓ Untucked shirts (men)
- ✓ Dresses and skirts shorter than mid-thigh (ladies)

During special events, the dress code may be subject to change; for example, jacket mandatory for all gentlemen.

On the Course and at all practice areas

Men

Slacks or Bermuda shorts (max. 3" above knee) must be worn on the golf course. Golf shirts with sleeves must be tucked in.

It is prohibited for all members and their guests to wear the following:

- ✓ Any denim clothing
- ✓ Jogging pants
- ✓ Sweat suits, biker shorts and short shorts
- ✓ Cargo pants and cargo shorts
- ✓ Overalls
- ✓ Golf caps turned backwards
- ✓ T-shirts
- ✓ Flip flop type sandals
- ✓ Untucked shirts

Ladies

Golf dresses, skirts, shorts (mid-thigh length), tailored slacks, sleeveless collared shirts and golf shirts and/or polos with sleeves (with or without a collar) are permitted.

It is prohibited for all members and their guests to wear the following:

- ✓ Any denim clothing
- ✓ Yoga pants, jogging pants, leggings and spandex
- ✓ Sweat suits, biker shorts and short shorts
- ✓ Cargo pants and cargo shorts
- ✓ Overalls
- ✓ Golf caps turned backwards
- ✓ T-shirts, tank tops, halter tops and crop tops
- ✓ Flip flop type sandals
- ✓ Dresses and skirts shorter than mid-thigh

Juniors

The same dress code applies to all junior members; in the clubhouse as well as on the course.

Pace of play policy | 4 hours or less

- 1) Players are responsible to keep up to the group in front (when the same # of golfers are following each other) of them at all times;
- 2) To be considered on pace, groups must be within 1 shot of the group ahead of them;
- 3) When there is no group in front to use as a reference, a playing time of a maximum 2 hours shall be used per 9 holes;
- 4) Groups unable to keep up will be moved to the appropriate position on the course;

Play ready golf

The biggest contributors to slow play are players who are not ready to hit when they should. There is no penalty for playing out of turn. If the person who is furthest from the hole is not ready for whatever reason, take the initiative and hit your shot.

Lost balls

Any player who may have lost their ball should not have the whole group look for it. It goes back to ready golf. If after you hit your shot and the player has not yet found his/her ball, go help them, but look quickly.

Initiative

Have one "Captain" in the foursome who will take charge of ensuring proper pace of play. Perhaps the person who made the booking is the captain. All it takes is one person to recognize that if you haven't seen anyone in front of you for a while, you may have fallen behind.

Golf cart

If carts are restricted to the cart paths, take a few clubs with you to your ball, especially if it lies on the other side of the fairway.

Score card

Mark your score on the next tee deck. If you are on pace, you should always have to wait a few minutes on the group ahead of you to clear the landing area or green. This is where you should mark down the scores from the last hole.

Professional staff

Please obey the Professional staff. If they ask you to pick up your pace, they are doing their job to ensure everyone, including your group enjoys their game. We welcome suggestions or comments on this important issue.

Course Maintenance

It is essential for all members and their guests to respect the golf etiquette **by repairing their divots, ball marks on the greens and rake the sand traps at all times.**
